At a meeting of the Harvard Square Clergy on Wednesday, February 28, 1973, it was voted that we go on record in support of the resolution prepared and being presented by the Neighborhood Health Station Crisis Coalition urging the City Council to "declare that it is the public policy of the City of Cambridge to guarantee the availability and accessibility of medical care to the residents of the low income neighborhoods of Cambridge by maintaining and supporting a Neighborhood Health Station Program; and further, that pursuant to this policy the City Manager is hereby ordered to provide within the Cambridge Hospital budget for the fiscal year 1973-74 sufficient funds to insure the operation of five Neighborhood Health Stations, adequately staffed with a minimum of a Nurse-Practitioner, Medical Receptionist and Health Aide, available on a full-time basis within each Health Station, serving the neighborhoods of East Cambridge, Donnelly Field, Area 4, Cambridgeport, Riverside, and North Cambridge."


