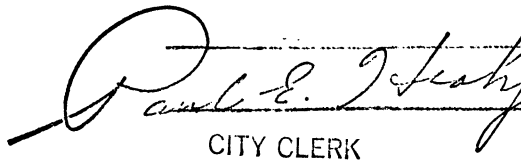

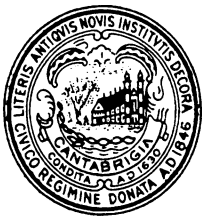

To the Honorable, the City Council:

In the early summer of 1972 the City Council authorized the borrowing of \$2,800,000 for the purpose of remodeling, reconstructing or making extraordinary repairs to the Cambridge Home for the Aged and Infirm and to accomplish this borrowing the City was obligated to appropriate the sum of \$150,000 to be included in the 1972 Tax Levy.

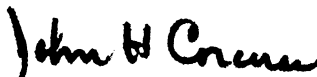
It has just come to my attention that the \$150,000 appropriation order has never been consummated and was not raised in the 1972 Tax Levy.

I have engaged an architect, Paul G. Feloney, to do the planning work. Bids on a portion of the work needed to be done have already been received.

In view of the non-existence of the \$150,000 appropriation, I have been advised by bond counsel that it will be necessary to duplicate all that has been done as it relates to the appropriation and the borrowing of funds.

It will therefore be appreciated if your Honorable Body will look with favor on the enclosed orders relating to this same matter.
