

TRAFFIC BOARD MEETING

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PRESENT: Chairman Vincent Panico, CAMBRIDGE, MASS. Peter Brusgulis, William Murphy, John Hickson, Dick Easler, Lauren Preston and Dave Bryant.

1. Tickets & Summons: Summons for 1975 tickets were mailed with the first ones due back on April 26, 1978. 650 are due each day. This may be lowered since the response is good. The indication is that all complaints will have to go before a Judge. Lauren Preston and Sgt. Brusgulis described what happens to the copies of the ticket when it is issued. The Tow & Hold list should be in shortly.
2. Vincent Panico asked the status of the University Road entrance onto Memorial Drive. The MDC has turned the request down but the City still feels it is necessary for good traffic flow in the S/W section of Harvard Square.
3. Red Line Ext.: Work is on schedule. \$42 million in contracts will be let in August 1978. Harvard Square station construction should begin in early 1979. Subway should be operating late '82 or early '83.
4. Construction on nine intersections is underway. Signals and islands should be completed this summer.
5. East Cambridge roads and redevelopment are still looking good for preliminary funding in June.
6. C.R.A. has picked M. Zuckermann as the developer for the Kendall Square triangle. MIT has hired a consultant to study their East Campus. The Traffic Dept. has been in contact with their Traffic Consultant, A.M.V.
