In Board of Aldermen, October 18th 1871

Whereas, It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that Elliot Street should be widened on its southerly side in accordance with a Report of the Committee on Roads and Bridges this day submitted to the Board;

Ordered, That a strip of land on the southerly side of Elliot Street, included between the present southerly line of said Elliot Street and a line drawn southerly from said southerly line and at unequal distances therefrom, be taken for public use, and laid out as a part of said Elliot Street, in accordance with a certain plan of said Elliot Street made by J. E. Chase and dated May 27th 1871 and now before this Board.

Ordered, That damages for the land so taken and for the injury to the buildings thereon be estimated and

awarded as follows.

To John Bryant for 1678 square feet of land at one dollar per foot \$1678.00
For damages to buildings and for expenses for the removal of the same 786.00
\$ 2464.00

To Mrs Phillip Curran for 1730 square feet of land at one dollar per foot \$1730.00
For damages to buildings and for expenses for the removal of the same 2250.00
\$ 3980.00

Total cost for widening \$ 6444.00

Ordered that thirty days be allowed to the persons whose land is taken for said widening, for the removal of their buildings, and other property standing on the land so taken as aforesaid,
