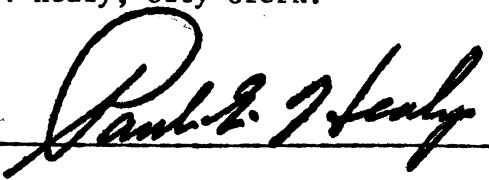

- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Police Chief, Fire Chief, Director of Traffic and Parking, License Commission and the Public Works Commissioner to make the appropriate arrangements to allow John F. Kennedy Street and Brattle Street to be closed between Mount Auburn Street and Harvard Square on Sunday, October 13, 1985 in order for the Harvard Square Business Association to participate in the "Oktoberfest", (rain date of Monday, October 14, 1985); and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Chief of Police be and hereby is authorized to issue a permit for the sale of food, beverages and merchandise so that the Business Association can comply with the Massachusetts laws on the required date; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the License Commission be and hereby is authorized to issue a license to sell wine and malt beverages by the cup; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to issue a sidewalk sales permit; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Health Department be and hereby is requested to issue a permit for the sale of food and beverages outdoors; and be it further
- ORDERED: That these permits be granted subject to the following conditions:-
1. That the Harvard Square Business Association provide six private security officers to maintain peace and order during this event.
 2. That the Harvard Square Business Association provide the necessary personnel to clean up the Oktoberfest area and public toilet facilities.

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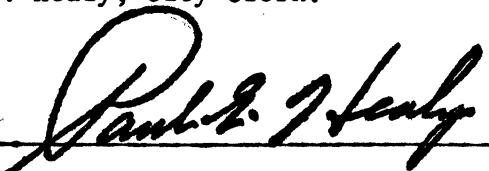
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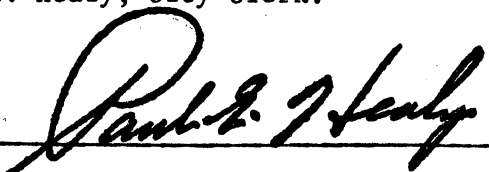
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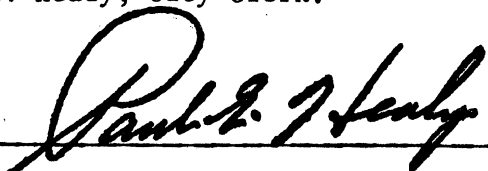

Pursuant to the conditions set by the City Council on Monday, September 9, 1985, in allowing the Harvard Square Business Association to hold its seventh annual Oktoberfest on Sunday, October 13, 1985 (with a raindate on Monday, October 14th):

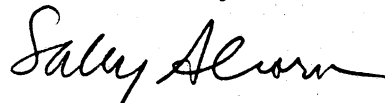
We have spoken with Police Chief Anthony Paolillo and with police detail supervisor, Sergeant Burns, both of whom assure us that our request for six special duty officers (one of whom will be a sergeant) has been logged for Sunday, October 13 (from noon until 7:00 p.m.) and will appear on the police roster the night before the Oktoberfest.

We have also written for permission to close the streets to the Department of Traffic and Parking. We have contacted the Department of Public Works to order a bandstand, barricades, a sign in front of City Hall, and a thorough clean-up afterwards paid for by the Association. We have order our usual allotment of public toilets from Comfort Castles, and have appeared before the Cambridge License Commission for our one-day wine and malt beverage licenses for our participants.

In view of our compliance (above), please notify the proper City officials of the Council's permission to hold the 1985 Oktoberfest and please ask them to cooperate with us in helping to make this Oktoberfest a safe and successful event.
