An Ordinance,
in addition to "an Ordinance, establishing a system of
accountability in the expenditures of the City".

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City
of Cambridge, as follows:—

1. There shall be appointed, at the commence-
ment of each municipal year, a Committee on
Finance, consisting of the Mayor and one Alderman,
the President and five members of the Common
Council; which Committee shall negotiate all loans
to the City which shall be authorized by the City
Council, and shall report the amount to the City
Treasurer.

2. The twelfth section of "an Ordinance, estab-
lishing a system of accountability in the expend-
itures of the City," passed on the twenty-fifth day of
May, 1846, is hereby repealed.
