Dear Mr. Sullivan:

The following status report is submitted for your consideration relative to four council orders passed by the City Council.

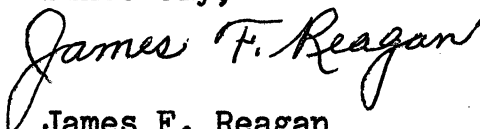
- Order No. 10 - Traffic control program on Walden Street. I have conferred with Mr. Teso and Captain Thomas Burke regarding this matter. Captain Burke informed me that both he and Mr. Teso have prepared and implemented a selective enforcement program for the relevant area.
- Order No. 12 - Relative to assigning foot patrolman to route 24. Route 24 as you know is primarily a commercial and industrial area of the City. Because of this the major portion of problems in this area occur between 6 PM and 5 AM. With these characteristics of the area in mind we have striven to provide police coverage with K-9 units. The rationale for the specific type of coverage is that the combination of police officers and dogs provide additional capabilities in a commercial area.
- Order No. 13 - Investigation of recent outbreak of fires. I have conferred with both Chief Cremins of the fire department and the Bureau of Criminal Investigation of the Police Department with respect to investigative activities relative to the fires. Lieutenant Clancy of B.C.I. has assured me that the personnel of the Bureau are doing all they possible can to determine the cause of the incidents. A comprehensive report covering all recent outbreaks of fires within the city will be submitted to your office shortly.

Order No. 16 - Selective traffic enforcement on River Street
between the hours of 7 PM and 6 AM.

consideration.

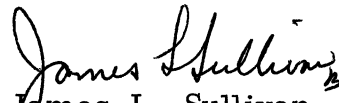
