In the Year One Thousand Eight Hun-  
dred and Seventy-two.

An Ordinance

in relation to the Care and Maintenance  
of West-Boston and Craigie's Bridges.

As is ordained by the City Council of  
the City of Cambridge, as follows:

Sec. 1. In May, Eighteen Hundred and  
seventy-two, and annually afterwards in  
March, the Mayor and Aldermen shall  
appoint a Commissioner for this City on  
West-Boston and Craigie's Bridges.

The Commissioner appointed the present  
year shall enter upon his duties forth-  
with, and shall hold office until the  
first day of May, Eighteen Hundred  
and seventy-two, and until his suc-  
cessor is appointed. The Commissioner ap-  
pointed annually afterwards shall hold  
office one year from the first day  
of May, in the year in which he is  
appointed, and until his successor is  
appointed. He may be removed at the

pleasure of the Mayor and Aldermen,  
and the vacancy for the unexpired term  
may be filled at any time. His compensa-  
tion shall be at the rate of five hun-  
dred dollars per annum, payable monthly.

Sec. 2. He shall have and exercise all  
the powers in relation to the care and  
management of said bridges conferred by  
the three hundred and second chapter  
of the Acts of the year Eighteen hundred  
and seventy.

Sec. 3. He shall annually, in December,  
report to the City Council a particular  
account of all expenditures, the number  
of times the draws have been opened, and  
other matters of general interest in re-  
lation to said bridges, for the previous  
year, with an estimate of the amount  
required of the City for the care and  
maintenance of said bridges for the  
year ensuing.
