Four years ago the Salvation Army in Cambridge established a day drop-in program for homeless men and women as an extension of the services they were providing in their 35 bed shelter. The day program is open to all and core services including meals, crisis intervention, informal counseling, health care and referrals are provided.

The shelter program is supported by the Department of Public Welfare but the Day Drop-In Program is supported primarily by the Salvation Army directly as well as a small amount of money from the City through the McKinney Homeless funds. The Salvation Army has submitted a proposal to the City to support an additional social worker for the Day Program whose responsibilities would include vocational counselling for those individuals ready to take the next step. The budget included in the Salvation Army's proposal requests \$19,500 to fund such a position although the City Council order references \$30,000. Based on an extensive discussion with the commanding officer of the Salvation Army in Cambridge, Captain S. M. Carroll, funding at a level of \$20,000 would provide the financial support necessary to fill the new position.

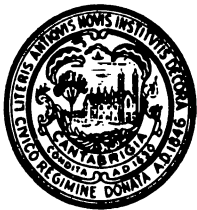
