Dear Honorable Cambridge City Councillors.

In accordance with Section 98 of Chapter 43 of the Massachusetts General laws and the City Council Rules, I, Jack, a professional problem solver, a.k.a. George F. Welch Jr., a Complainant against Continental Cablevision and a Complainant against Cambridge Community Television, its board of directors, its officers, its executive director, for the reasons set out in the attached 2 (two) page Complaint, demand to be heard on the Complaint against City Manager, Robert Healy, Issuing Authority for Cable Television licences for the City of Cambridge and against Cambridge city employee Edward "Ned" Casey, the City Manager's designee as Issuing Authority for continuing violations of their duties under section 104 of Chapter 43 of the Massachusetts General laws and under section 11, and 19 of chapter 166A of the General laws and section 14 of the City of Cambridge's Cable Television license, and the First, Fifth and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution and Chapter 30A of the General laws by willfully refusing to act on my attached Complaint against Continental Cablevision and Cambridge Community Television et. al.

At the hearing, I also demand a declaration by each City Councillor as to whether he or she will join me as a Complainant.

This Complaint amends my August 14, 1990 Complaint against:

(part #3) the officers, board of directors and
executive director of Cambridge Community Television and,

(part #1) against Continental Cablevision

to include the demand that the Commissioner of the Massachusetts Cable
Television Commission conduct a public hearing in the City of Cambridge
Massachusetts, as required under G.L. c. 166A sections 2A, 11, 15 and 19 to
consider revocation of Continental Cablevision's license to operate the
Cambridge Cable Television System for:

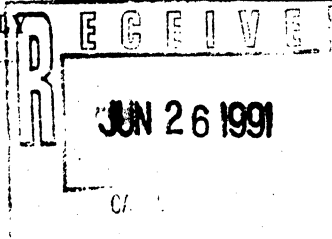
1. (a) unlawfully doing business in the City of Cambridge, Massachusetts
between February 25, 1988 and the present and

(b) unlawfully charging Cambridge, Massachusetts residents and
businesses money for cable services and

(c) unlawfully charging money for public access to the Cambridge Cable
Television System, between February 25, 1988 and the present,

in violation of the requirements of the Cambridge Final Cable Television License
that there exist, between February 25, 1988 and the present, a Contract between
Continental Cablevision and a federally tax exempt not-for-profit corporation,
Cambridge Public Access Corporation (CPAC), organized by the City to facilitate
open, free, non-discriminatory access to the Cable Television System and to
protect the public interest in the development of public services and
programming and other services as provided in the Final Cable Television License
