- WHEREAS: Dan entered the service of the City on September 14, 1941 at which time he was assigned to Ladder No. 2 where he remained until 1943 when he went to serve his country during World War II as a member of the United States Army and upon his honorable discharge he was reinstated to active duty in the Fire Department in 1946 and on April 15, 1951 he began his ascension in the Department when through promotional examination he was appointed to the rank of Lieutenant at which time he was assigned to Engine No. 4 remaining there until August 4, 1952 when he was assigned to Engine No. 8; and
- WHEREAS: Dan never stopped educating himself in the fire sciences, always endeavoring to stay on top of the latest technological advances in order that he could provide the very best to the City he loved and the job he loved; and
- WHEREAS: Dan continued to rise through the ranks, being promoted to Captain on January 29, 1956 and to Deputy Chief on February 24, 1963 the position he held until November 2, 1979 when he was appointed Chief of Department by then City Manager James L. Sullivan; and
- WHEREAS: During his tenure as Chief, And was credited with the creation of the Arson Squad whose outstanding work and dedication has been praised by this City Council on various occasions; now therefore be it
