Sprinkling Ball Fields

Please be advised that the Public Works Department did water ball fields last summer as often as we were able to. Six fields have sprinklers under them that are constantly in need of repairs. We have repaired these sprinklers on numerous occasions and endeavor to use them as often as possible.

A recent survey completed last week shows the following already in need of being done.

- 1 - Donnelly Field - two breaks, not operating - heads?
- 2 - Hoyt Field - heads leaking
- 3 - Common - line breaks and heads, major repairs
- 4 - Tobin Field - numerous breaks, further checking necessary
- 5 - St. Peters Field - 2 lines broken
- 6 - Comeau Field - 1 line broken

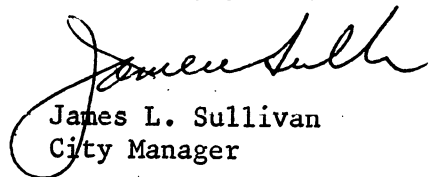
