Subject Council Order #2 dated May 11, 1987 "Porter Square Pedestrian Lights and Parking at 1900 Mass. Ave."

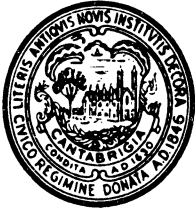
We have checked the pedestrian lights in Porter Square and had our signal contractor replace the bulbs and pushbuttons which were malfunctioning.
