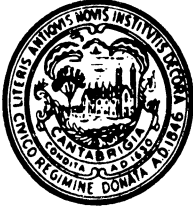
SUBJECT: Council Order #002 dated 1/6/97

RE: Three accidents in a 48 hour period in the East Cambridge area

The Department is reviewing Third and Gore Street for safety improvements. The accident data has been compiled and reviewed. The vehicles exiting Gore Street eastbound are the problem. These vehicles currently have a stop sign to control their access to the intersection.

At the East Cambridge Planning Team meeting on February 13, we proposed to the community making one block of Gore Street one way westbound to reduce vehicles coming into the intersection of Gore and Third. Residents at the meeting did not support the proposal. The Department is posting additional warning signs in the intersection and will continue to monitor the accident records.

We anticipate meeting again with the community on this issue as well as to discuss traffic calming treatments for Third Street which is on the Public Works schedule for resurfacing.
