Resolve of the City of Cambridge Establishing April 23, 1983 as the
Sovereign Military Hospitalers Order of Saint George In Carinthia Day

WHEREAS:

1. April 23rd, 1983 is the Christian Feast of Saint George, the Patron and the Protector of the Needy;
2. Saint George is also the Patron of Chivalry and the Holy Protector of the Sovereign Military Hospitalers Order of Saint George in Carinthia, a bastion of strength since the Crusades;
3. The Order of Saint George in Carinthia is celebrating the 710th anniversary of its founding on April 23rd, 1983;
4. The Order of Saint George in Carinthia is dedicated to the principles of charity, justice and liberty;
5. The Order of Saint George is holding its first public investiture of Knights and Dames in Massachusetts on April 23rd, 1983 at the compound of Our Lady of the Cedars of Lebanon;
6. The Order of Saint George in Carinthia is investing many Cantabridgians as Knights and Dames from among outstanding celebrated citizens of this great city;
7. In 1973 at the Brusck Medical Center in the city of Cambridge the Order of Saint George in Carinthia established for the poor its first free clinic in the United States.
8. This great and glorious city should recognize and honor institutions which support and uphold traditions related to chivalry, truth, justice, charity, liberty and the value of all human beings;
