WHEREAS:

Visitors to the Art Festival were requested to donate money at the entrance to the Common, and

WHEREAS:

Vendors were parked on the Common selling their wares to the visitors of the Art Festival, therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to initiate an investigation into this matter to determine whether or not adequate permission had been granted by the City of Cambridge to the parties concerned and if so under what authority, statute or City Ordinance was this permission granted and why the City Council was not notified by letter prior to the Art Festival being held, and be it further

RESOLVED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to take whatever action he deems necessary to prohibit this type of use on the Cambridge Common in the future, and to report back to this City Council within two weeks the action taken by him.
