- WHEREAS:** Professor Haskins began his undergraduate training at Long Island University, receiving his bachelor of science degree, magna cum laude in 1949 and attaining a masters degree in 1952 at the Adelphi School of Social Work; and
- WHEREAS:** Professor Haskins furthered his educational training with courses in supervision and administration at the New York School of Social Work, the Adelphi School of Social Work and at Hunter College, Graduate Division of Education as well as participating in Independent Study at Harvard University, Graduate School of Education in 1969-70; and
- WHEREAS:** Professor Haskins is noted for his dedication, professional work and untiring efforts on behalf of the black community in providing leadership for better schools, for the building of Roxbury Community College and for lending his experience and expertise to a host of community and civic projects; and
- WHEREAS:** Professor Haskins has been the recipient of numerous academic honors and civic awards; and
- WHEREAS:** Professor Haskins has published numerous articles and writings on the educational process and has been awarded several research grants and awards; and
- WHEREAS:** Upon his retirement, Professor Haskins will be relocating to Atlanta, Georgia from Cambridge where he has made his home; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That this City Council go on record extending to Professor Kenneth W. Haskins its very best wishes, its congratulations and its hopes for success in all future endeavors during his retirement years; and

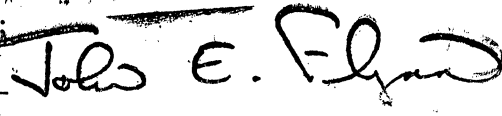
