COUNCILLOR WALTER SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: This City Council was saddened upon learning of the death of Dr. Sydney Grace, former Chief of Obstetrics - Gynecology at the Cambridge Hospital; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Grace graduated in 1929 from Clark University and received his medical degree from Boston University in 1936 and interned at the Cambridge Hospital prior to his entering the armed forces in 1942; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Grace served with the Fourth Armored Division in Europe and was discharged with the rank of Major in 1946, with such decorations as the Silver Star with two oak leaf clusters, a Bronze Star with an oak leaf cluster, four battle stars and a French medal; and
- WHEREAS: Once discharged from active duty Dr. Grace returned to private practice and in addition to becoming a consultant on the staff of the Cambridge Hospital joined the staff of the Beth Israel; and
- WHEREAS: Although Dr. Grace spent many long hours in the practice of medicine he still found time for civic interests such as past commander of the Newton Jewish War Veterans and as a member of Binai B'rith Temple Ohabei Shalom and its Brotherhood in Brookline; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our deepest sympathy to Mrs. Ethel Grace and the entire Grace family at their time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Grace on behalf of the entire City Council.
