Re: Site Feasibility Funding

On behalf of the West Cambridge Youth Center Steering Committee, I am respectfully requesting the allocation of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) in FY'98 City of Cambridge funds to be utilized for expenditures related to ascertaining the most appropriate site for a new youth facility in West Cambridge.

The Steering committee has been meeting for most of the past year to produce a needs assessment for such a facility, reviewing demographics for the same purpose and exploring a number of possible sites. In presenting the *Needs Assessment for a New West Cambridge Youth Center* at a community meeting held at the Tobin School in March, a discussion of potential sites also occurred. It is the desire of the committee to work in a timely and efficient manner in moving to a final recommendation related to site. It is for this goal that the request for site feasibility funding is made. In our judgment, any of the sites under active consideration would need soil analysis or more in-depth assessment on which a determination could be made as to suitability.

The West Cambridge Youth Center Steering Committee is well aware of the interest and leadership provided by Mayor Russell and members of the Cambridge City Council. The steering committee is committed to moving forward in our efforts and desire to work with elected officials and all city offices to make the vision of a new West Cambridge Youth Center a reality. It is in this spirit that this request is made.
