ORDERED: That the City Manager provide this Council with a written statement of the criteria which have been and will be utilized since the date of the hiring freeze to justify creation of new positions in any city department as well as the transfer of personnel from one department to another and the source of funding for the salary of same. The City Manager is requested to provide this Council with a list of such appointments which have been made since the date of the hiring freeze up through this date, indicating the salary of each such position and the source of funding therefor. The City Manager is requested to provide additional such lists on a monthly basis through June, 1990; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager provide response to the above request by October 2, 1989 and subsequent lists be provided by the first scheduled Council Meeting of each month through June, 1990.
