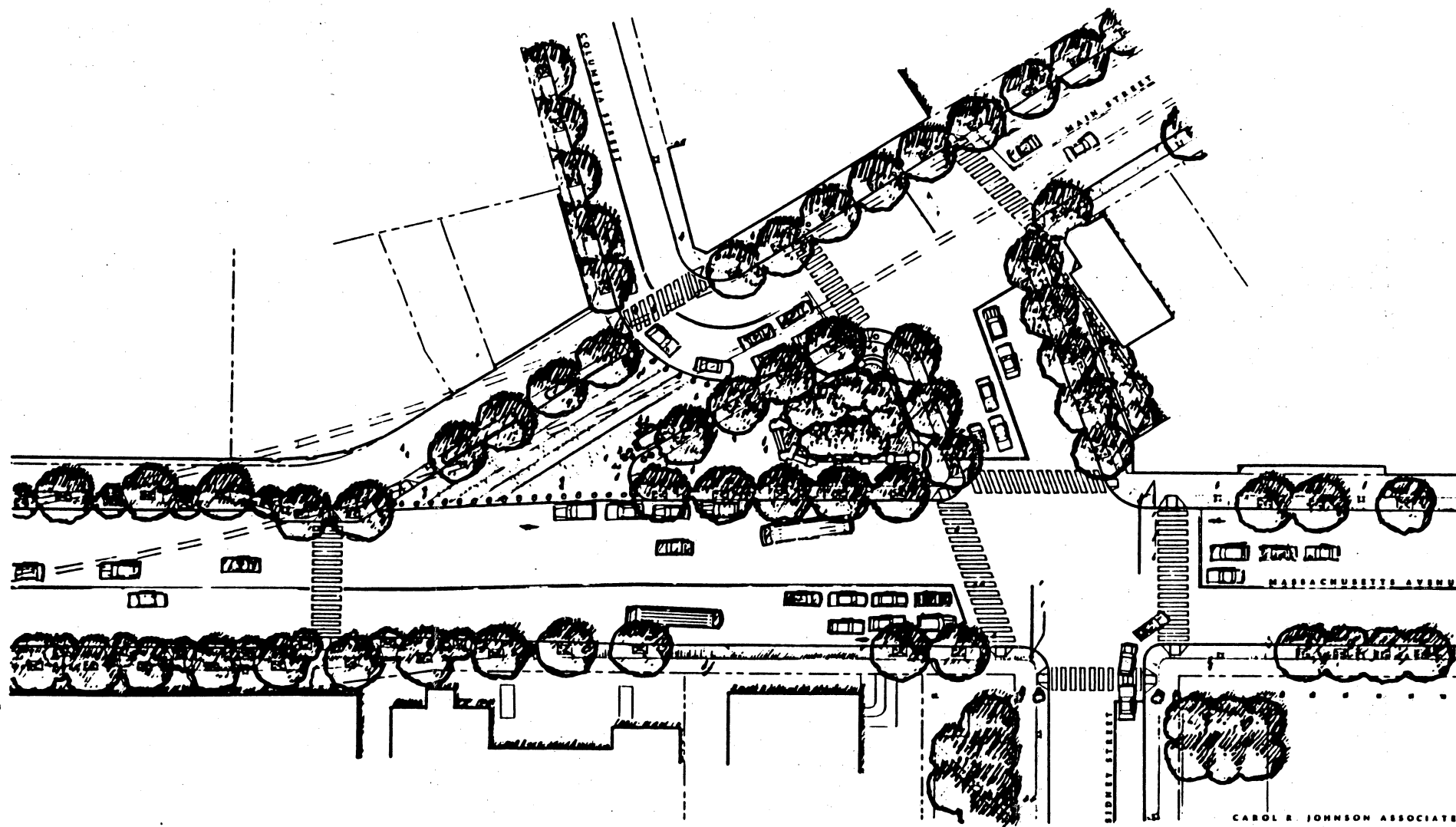
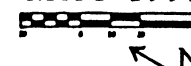
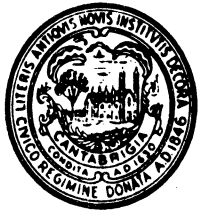

To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 17, regarding a report on whether a crosswalk could be installed in Central Square, between Bioran and Cezanne/Economy Hardware, please be advised of the following:

With the present configuration of Lafayette Square, i.e. Main Street running through Massachusetts Avenue, there is no time in the signal sequence that vehicles would not be crossing the crosswalk if it were installed. However, when Lafayette Square is redesigned (map attached), Main Street will not continue through to Massachusetts Avenue and it is planned for a crosswalk to be installed at that time.
