In response to City Council Order #9 of 4/30/90 regarding a weekly update of the progress on the robberies in Harvard Square, two arrests were made during the week of April 22. The last reported incident of a "smash and grab" was on April 25, 1990 at the Radio Shack located at 28 JFK Street. This incident resulted in an arrest. There have been no reported incidents since.

The Police Department has deployed extra resources, uniformed and undercover, to Harvard Square during the late night/early morning hours in an attempt to stop the occurrences of "smash and grab". The operation has been successful.
