In response to Awaiting Report No. 44 regarding the status of a chestnut tree at the corner of Hollis Street and Rindge Avenue, the Public Works Department has determined that the middle of the tree is rotted and could be hazardous to pedestrians and passing vehicles. We are hoping to hire a trained arborist in FY90 who will oversee the planting, maintenance, and removal of all street trees.
