- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to have City staff research this problem and report the findings and recommendations to this City Council by February 10, 1986; and be it further ordered
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to convene an emergency meeting immediately with relevant social agencies and particularly with the representatives of various religious institutions as well as other concerned persons to discuss ways in which they as well as the City can properly begin to redress the unfortunate plight of the homeless in Cambridge.
