In Board of Aldermen, Dec. 4, 1872

Ordered,

That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to draw his Order on the City Treasurer in favor of Thomas Mullins for the sum of Three Hundred ^{+ fifty} Dollars, whenever said Mullins shall have furnished the City with a release of his claim to the land on Third Street from which his steps were ordered to be removed, and all claim for damages to buildings, or otherwise, caused by said removal.

Said sum to be charged to Appropriation for Incidental Expenses.
