Dear Council Members:

The Donnelly Field area is plagued with repeated acts of vandalism, speeding motor vehicles, public drinking and other crimes such as drug dealing. We, the residents of the Harrington area ask for a public hearing before the City Council on Monday, June 1st to help us secure:

- 1) More police protection for our area.
- 2) A traffic supervisor at the intersection of Hunting and Cambridge Street for the school year.

Over 50 local people attended a forum May 13th with Lt. Donnelly of the Police Department, Lauren Preston from the Traffic & Parking Department, and other city officials to discuss how to achieve more extensive law enforcement for our community. Last year we had similar meetings. Now we feel our concerns are so pressing, and we need to explain them before the City Council.
