WHEREAS: Nonetheless, area residents are still concerned and fearful for their safety and the safety of their children, therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to confer with the Traffic Director to see if some plan might be formulated to increase the safety on this dangerous area of Pleasant Street.
