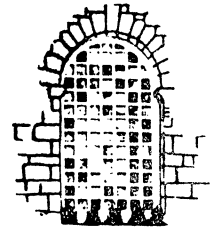

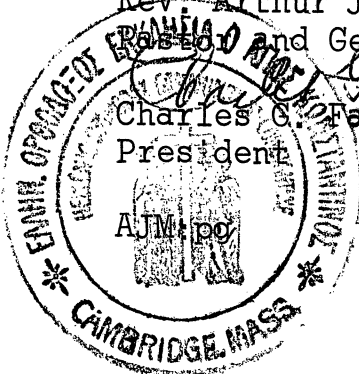

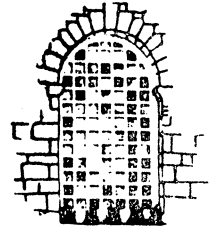

front of the City Hall in Cambridge.

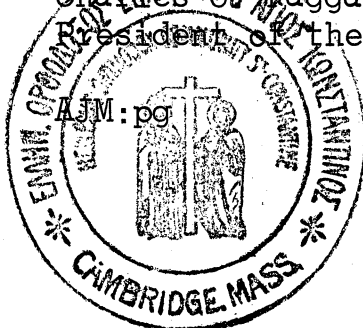
It will be a pleasure to have you present at the
