Kenneth J. Simmons

Kenneth J. Simmons earned the rank of Eagle Scout more than twenty-five years ago on September 25, 1957. He has maintained an active scouting career from the time he entered scouting until today. He has served with distinction through the years as a local Council Executive Board Member and Council Commissioner from 1969 to the present. As a young scout, Ken Simmons was the only scout from his local territory to earn the Eagle Palms and the Explorer Silver Award.

Ken has been recognized by the Diocesan Scout Committee with the St. George Award; he has been a Vigil Member of Kahagon Lodge since 1961, and was presented with the Silver Beaver in 1973. He has attended two Jamboree's and led an expedition to Philmont Scout Reservation.

He has given distinguished service to his nation as a Captain in the U.S. Army, where he served as Intelligence Officer in the Viet Nam War. While serving in Natrang he was awarded the Bronze Star.

In his professional life, he has distinguished himself as an Attorney engaged in General Practice of Law. He has been admitted to practice before the Federal Bar and the U.S. Supreme Court. He is a member of the Board of Directors of the Cambridge, Arlington, and Belmont Bar Association; a Member of the Massachusetts Bar Association; American Bar Association, and the Middlesex County Bar Association.

He has served on the Finance Committee for the Town of Arlington from 1974 to the present time. Past President of the Rotary Club of Arlington; Past Presiding Justice Cambridge Lodge B.P.O.E. Elks; Vice President of the Cambridge Portuguese Credit Union; Member of St. Anthony's Holy Name Society; Former Secretary of the Building Committee for the new Portuguese Church, and a Notary Public.

Ken Simmons has helped motivate Scouting in Cambridge, and has the concerns of young people at heart. He is truly deserving to have the honor and rank of - Distinguished Eagle Scout bestowed upon him.

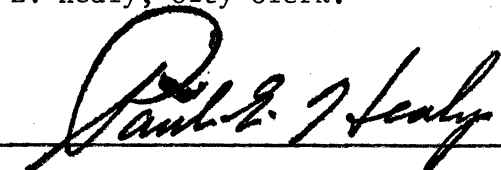
