City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, Oct. 26th 1889.

Ordered, Whereas a private way in Ward Five called Russell Street; has heretofore been devoted to the public use by the owners of the adjoining lands and is now in a fit condition to become a public highway;

And whereas it is adjudged by the Mayor and Aldermen that the public necessity and convenience require that said street be laid out as a public highway, and that no persons will be damaged thereby, or be entitled to any compensation from the City: therefore be it

Ordered: That said private way be and hereby is laid out and established as a public highway, by the name of Russell Street, agreeably to a Plan thereof, drawn by Warren Sargent, bearing date Aug. 6. 1885, and now on file in the office of the City Clerk, - to wit: from North Avenue as far as the Somerville line; the same to be forty feet in width as delineated by the red lines on said Plan.
