

CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

IN CITY COUNCIL

October 8, 1929.

ORDERED:-

That the City Solicitor be authorized to file a petition in the Land Court for the registration in the name of the City of Cambridge of a certain parcel of land situated in Cambridge in the County of Middlesex and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, bounded and described as follows:-

Being Lot 21 on a plan of desirable house lots belonging to Charles A. Mason, W. A. Mason & Sons, Surveyors, dated December, 1906 said plan being recorded with Middlesex South District Deeds, Book of Plans 165, Plan 24, and bounded and described as follows:-

Northerly by Vassal Lane as shown on said plan, eightytwo and 56/100 (82.56) feet;
Westerly by land now or formerly of Frank Alasevich, one hundred twelve and 25/100 (112.25) feet;
Southerly by Lot 22 on said plan, being land now or formerly of Henry J. Kennedy, twenty-six and 41/100 (26.41) feet;
Easterly by Lot 20 on said plan, being land now or formerly of Harold S. Smith, ninety-two and 88/100 (92.88) feet.

Containing 5100 square feet of land.

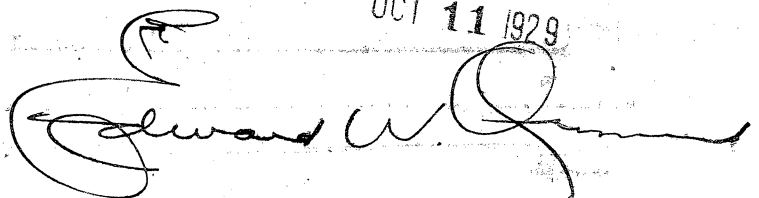
Said parcel is also shown as Lot 101 on Block Plan No. 233, dated August, 1913, in the office of the Assessors of the City of Cambridge.
