A hearing was held at the City Manager's Office on June 3, 1992 at 2:00 p.m. Russell B. Higley, City Solicitor was appointed by the City Manager to be the Hearing Officer.

A complaint was received at the City Manager's Office from Constable Allan Korb that the appointment of George Perry as a Constable to serve civil process was invalid since Mr. Perry was a resident of Somerville.

Sgt. John Drewicz of the Cambridge Police Department conducted an investigation and determined that Mr. Perry in fact lived and voted in Somerville. Mr. Perry appeared at the Hearing and admitted that he lived in Somerville. He also stated that when he was first appointed he was a resident of Cambridge, but at some date had moved to Somerville.

After a review of all facts it is my determination that Mr. Perry resides in Somerville as of his appointment of January 1, 1991 and therefore his appointment as a Constable to serve civil process should be revoked since the appointment violates Chapter 2.20 of the Ordinance of the City of Cambridge.
