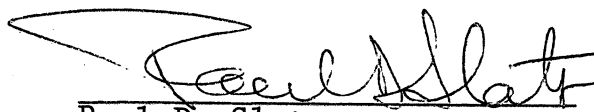
Re: 9 Ellery Street, Cambridge
