IN CITY COUNCIL
September 14, 1987

- WHEREAS: Under its present policy the Cambridge Housing Authority can only provide available emergency housing to the homeless if they are victims of fire or flood; and
- WHEREAS: The C.H.A. selection criteria exclude the rest of the homeless in Cambridge from emergency housing; and
- WHEREAS: In the absence of sufficient local emergency housing, some Cambridge residents with the assistance of the Department of Public Welfare must live in rental housing in other Massachusetts cities and towns which results in the children being unable to attend Cambridge schools and a loss of friends and other social contacts for the family; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the Cambridge City Council respectfully urges the Cambridge Housing Authority to modify its housing policies in order to permit the homeless in Cambridge to be eligible for C.H.A. housing.
