- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Traffic Department to complete these items before the opening day of school, to ensure that area neighborhood children are protected:
1. Concord Avenue - "Slow" signs at rear of school, near the playground;
 2. Poplar Road - Possibility of "No Entering" sign from Parkway;
 3. Fayerweather & Saville Streets - Dangerous crossing - wide intersection; white lines need re-painting;
 4. Left Turn Only sign posted on Chilton Street, opposite parking lot for bank;
 5. Zebra-striped lines painted on the crossings in the vicinity of Huron Avenue and Chilton Street.
