It is the consensus of these interested community groups, the full membership of the Health and Hospital Committee and the Hospital officials, that the best, cheapest and only location ready for immediate occupancy is the premises located at 2400 Massachusetts Avenue, and

WHEREAS:

This property is owned by the Junction Realty Trust in which a part of said ownership may present a possible conflict of interest, therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That this City Council go on record requesting a written legal opinion from the City Solicitor as to the possible conflict of interest and as to whether or not said conflict could be waived, and be it further

RESOLVED:

That the City Solicitor be requested to forward his opinion to this Council within one week.
