





Dear Mr. Cole:

I take pleasure in appointing you as the State Member of the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority to fill the unexpired term of Thaddeus R. Beal, who has resigned and whose term will expire on November 14, 1979.

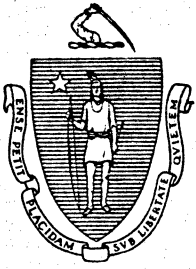
In light of your appointment, I hope that you will remain in close communication with the Department regarding any problems or questions you may have in carrying out your responsibilities.




