ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge as revised in 1972 and now designated as "The Code of the City of Cambridge" Chapter 3 entitled "Advertising", Section 3-1 entitled "Projections over street; permit; fee", the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Edward Blank, Jr. for the erection of a flag at 1 Thorndike Street (First Street side).

Provided that, before erecting the above named flag, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said flag.

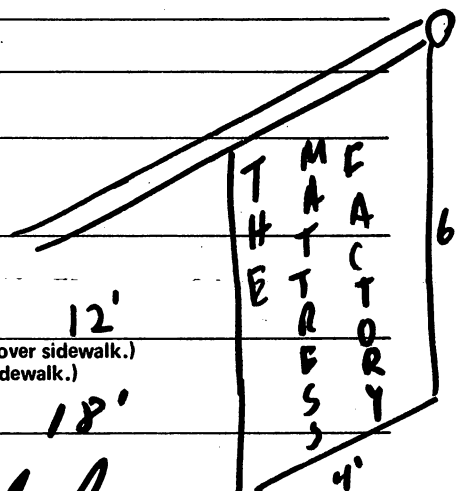
