In Board of Aldermen, Oct 11/1867

The petition of Richard Mathews and others asking to have a dangerous sidewalk in Lee st, put in safe condition for public travel has been considered by the Committee on Roads and Bridges. The Locality complained of has been examined and found to be unsafe.

The Committee unanimously recommend that the Superintendent of streets be instructed to set edge stones, and make such repairs as will insure safety in public travel on so much of the sidewalk as lies between the Block and the estate of L S Larned
