NEW ENGLAND TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY

New England Telephone and Telegraph Company ("NET" or Company") has filed a tariff of rates and charges for a service that would provide integrated voice circuit switched data and packet switched data over a single access line ("ISDN"). The Company also proposes to offer other optional features with the proposed ISDN service including all management functions and display of call-related information. NET proposes to offer this service to certain one-party residence or business main telephone exchange service lines.

(Integrated Service Digital Network [ISDN] Basic Rate).

The Department will conduct a public hearing on the above matter at its hearing room, 1210 Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts on Thursday, June 13, 1991 at 10:00 a.m.

The petitioner, New England Telephone Company, is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date in the Boston Globe, The Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and the Evening Gazette (Worcester), and to serve a copy hereof at least twenty-one days prior to said date on the attached list, and to make return of service and publication at the time of the hearing.
