- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Detective Edward McNulty will retire from active duty on the Police Department, completing thirty-two years of outstanding service to the citizens of Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Edward McNulty was appointed as a Patrolman in March of 1950 and worked in various assignments prior to being assigned to the Accident Investigation Bureau in February of 1960 and served in that capacity until his elevation to the rank of Detective in January of 1963 and served in the Juvenile Division until June of 1971; prior to his transfer to the Prosecutor's Office in Middlesex Superior Court, where he directed the preparation of court cases for the members of the department; and
- WHEREAS: Detective McNulty, a graduate of Rindge Technical High School continued his education by taking evening courses at Massachusetts Bay Community College and Boston State College, in order to increase his knowledge and comprehension of law enforcement subjects; and
- WHEREAS: Edward McNulty represented the best in law enforcement and won the admiration of his fellow officers by his diligence and kindly counsel to all who sought his assistance and was the recipient of a citation for his bravery in preventing serious injuries to fellow officers in the Courtroom in 1976; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its gratitude and appreciation to Detective Edward McNulty as he completes thirty-two years of public service to the citizens of Cambridge and to further extend its every good wish for a healthy and happy retirement; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Detective McNulty on behalf of the entire City Council.

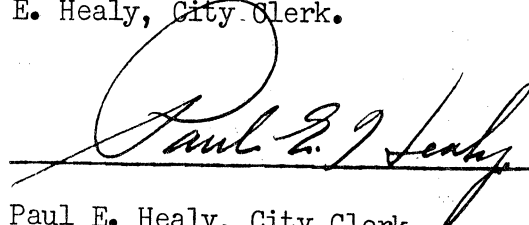

- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Detective Edward McNulty will soon retire from active duty on the Police Department, completing thirty-two years of service; and
- WHEREAS: Ed was first appointed to the Department in March of 1950, working in various assignments and patrols until February of 1960 when he was assigned to the Accident Investigation Bureau, a position he held until January, 1963; and
- WHEREAS: Officer Edward McNulty was promoted to Detective in January of 1963, at which time he was assigned to the Juvenile Division, a position he held with distinction, until June of 1971 when he was transferred to the Prosecutor's Office at the Middlesex County Court House, in order to assist members of the Police Department with the many complex problems resulting from various arrests; and
- WHEREAS: Detective McNulty, always searching to improve himself, is a graduate of Rindge Technical High School, Massachusetts Bay Community College and Boston State College, having completed many of these courses at night because of his difficult schedule during the normal work day; and
- WHEREAS: The outstanding performance of Detective McNulty in a Middlesex County Courtroom in 1976 prevented serious injury to fellow officers and court personnel was cited by Police Chief Nicholas Fratto; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its gratitude and appreciation to Detective Edward McNulty as he completes thirty-two years of public service to the citizens of Cambridge and to further extend its every good wish for a healthy and happy retirement; and be it further
