- WHEREAS: This act of generosity and humanity should not pass without acknowledgment; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our appreciation to Mr. Ralph Hoagland and to all the people at 33 Dunster Street who helped to make Thanksgiving a little nicer for some people who otherwise might not have had the opportunity to celebrate; and further be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and is hereby requested to forward to Mr. Hoagland a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution.
