WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Need Street

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *forty feet* in width between

Spruce and Harvey Streets

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

Wm A. Mason

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *and that 30 days be allowed for the removal of all obstructions standing thereon,*
