- WHEREAS: There is substantial concern in many neighborhoods about safety issues caused by moving violations of automobiles; and
- WHEREAS: It is impossible with the present Police staffing to cover all neighborhoods adequately; and
- WHEREAS: It is noted that the City is very successful at ticketing parking violators because of the regular routes of the traffic control officers; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager with the Police Chief consider development of a plan that would increase the Police staff and allow officers to be assigned regular routes especially oriented to catching violators of serious traffic violations.
