- WHEREAS: Coors Company has broken nineteen unions of Coors workers in the past twenty years; and
- WHEREAS: The organized labor movement across the United States and including the Massachusetts AFL-CIO continues in its support of the long-standing Coors Boycott; and
- WHEREAS: Several local affiliates such as Local 26 of the International Hotel, Restaurant and Institutional Employees union continue to support the Coors Boycott; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council endorses the Coors Boycott and calls on the good citizens of Cambridge to boycott all products of the Adolph Coors Company including Coors, Coors Light, Herman Joseph's 1868, Golden Lager and Killians Irish Red, so long as the national organized labor boycott endorsed by AFL-CIO shall continue.
