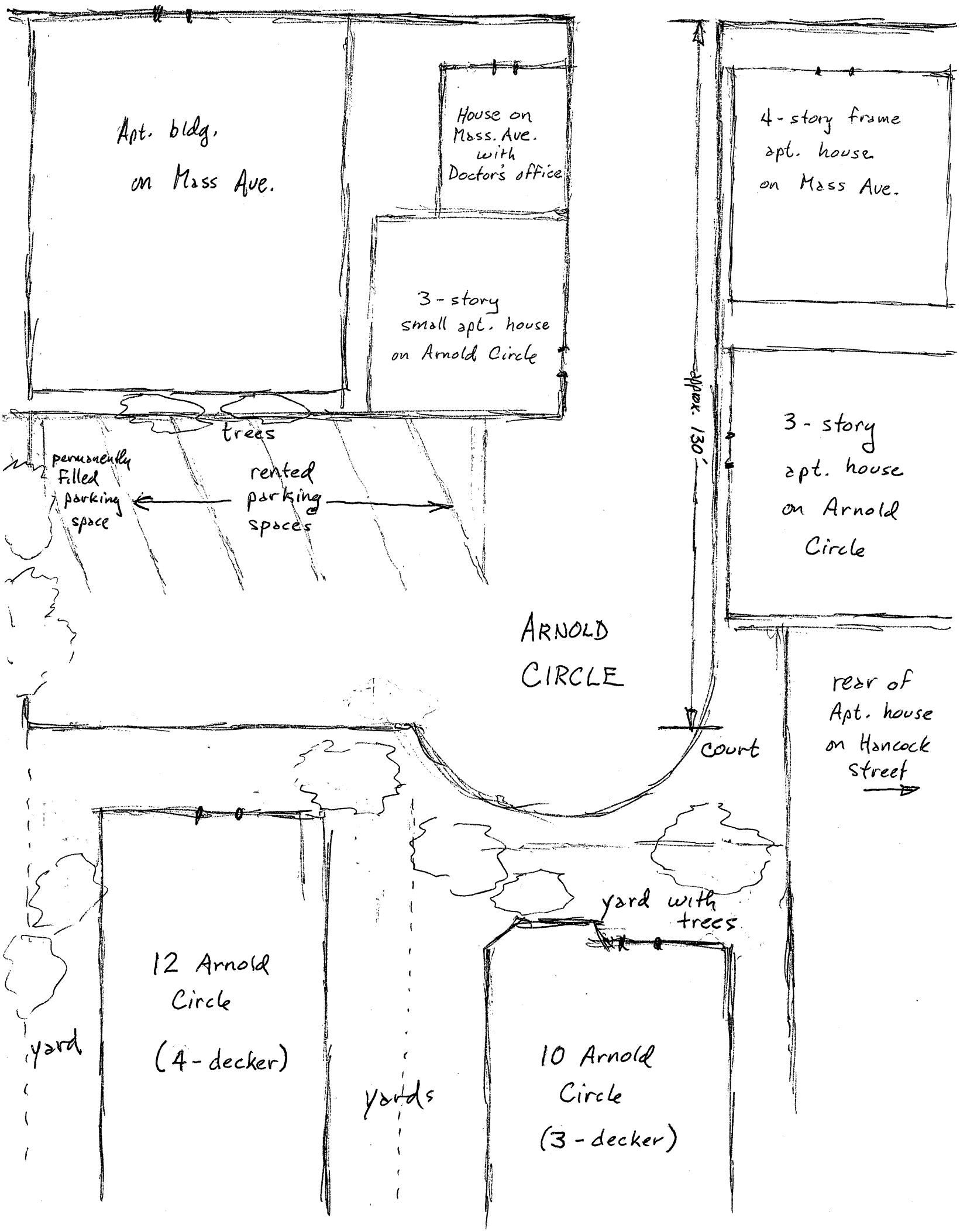

Dear Mr. Healy:

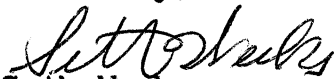
At your suggestion in our phone conversation yesterday I'm writing to find out what I can do, and what the City of Cambridge can do, to keep my apartment from being converted into offices.

I live at 12 Arnold Circle, apt. 1. The apartment manager, Dick Glass, lives in apt. 2. On Monday, June 2nd, he told me that he intends to move out in October 1980 and at that time will convert his apartment into offices. Then, in another six months, (spring of '81), he plans to convert my apartment into offices. Even if, by some chance, he never converts my apartment, I don't want to have commercial offices across the hall from me. (The manager acts in behalf of the owner, Kenneth Krohn, who is currently in federal prison.)

The accompanying sketch of Arnold Circle shows it to be an unusually restful, tree-lined, pleasant nook just off Mass Avenue. There are exactly four available parking spaces in the turn-around, and they are all rented to tenants in the various buildings. When even one or two more cars park--illegally--in the area, it becomes cramped and movement is difficult. It would be a great shame to allow offices to be opened in the 3- and 4-decker houses in the Circle, ruining the quiet residential atmosphere.

Please communicate my concern to the City Manager and City Council and let me know what I can do.
