WHEREAS: This dumpster is also a source of other problems to residents particularly its foul odor on warm days and the rodents it attracts, now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Director of the Housing Authority to find a suitable new location for the dumpster and report back to this City Council in two weeks.
