ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Consumer Credit Union for the erection of a sign at 759 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge.

Provided that, before erecting the above named sign, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said sign.

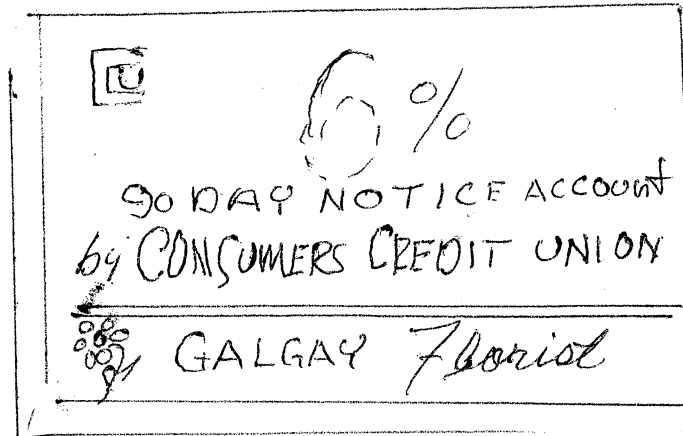

NOTICE - REGULATIONS

SEC. 3608. BUILDING CODE. . PROJECTING SIGNS

1. A projecting sign shall be constructed wholly of incombustible materials, with a metal frame and supports; shall not project out from the wall of a building or other structure a horizontal distance of more than 6 feet; and shall be secured in a rigid manner.

2. Any part of such a sign shall not be less than 10 feet, nor more than 45 feet, above the grade beneath the sign.
