WHEREAS: The issue of truck traffic, through residential areas is of continuing concern because of safety and noise issues; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager is requested to have the Traffic Department to survey Upland Road and Oxford Street to determine ways of reducing truck traffic in these streets through either

- (1) a truck ban,
or, if that is impossible,
- (2) improved signage that gives trucks other routes.
- (3) directing specific companies to use other routes, as it is unlikely that large trucks need to go through these streets except for their own convenience or because they are lost.
