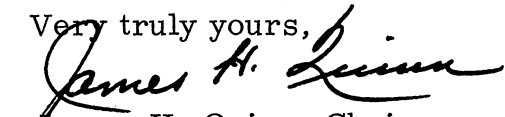
Following the awards program there will be a small colation.
